Whales are nearby when this flag is flying. Slow down and proceed with caution.

IF YOU SEE THIS FLAG

- 1. Slow down.
- 2. Be prepared to adjust course.
- 3. Follow Be Whale Wise to comply with the law and turn off depth sounders and fish finders.

IF YOU HAVE THIS FLAG

- 1. When you detect whales at or within 1000 yds (1 km), slow to stop, raise flag.
- 2. Follow Be Whale Wise to comply with the law and turn off depth sounders and fish finders.
- 3. Lower flag once you or the whales leave.

- Offers a sanctuary from underwater noise and watercraft presence for sensitive marine species utilizing the area, including Southern Resident killer whales.
- Extends ¼ mile offshore and ½ mile offshore around Lime Kiln Lighthouse.
- Encouraged for all watercraft, all year, at all times.
- Kayakers launching from San Juan County Parks follow the conditions of a special use permit program called K.E.L.P. (see *bewhalewise.org*)
